He was a survivor of Battle of the Bulge. Later, Stanley enlisted in the U.S. Navy Reserves and was called to duty to serve in the Korean War from 1950 until 1951.

Stanley was a member of the East Side AC, Knights of Columbus Holy Trinity Council 4400, Cantigny Post #367 VFW, American Legion Post 1080, Ingalls Park AC and he was a retiree of Northern Illinois Steel.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Peter Paul and Mary (nee Szumavzek) Gembicki; two sisters, Irene Gembicki and Frances Torleson; and his late companion, Marjorie Maslan.

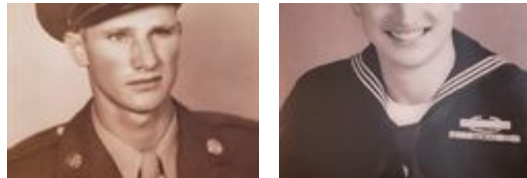
